Species: **Dalbergia sissoo**

Dalbergia sissoo is a medium to large deciduous tree with a spreading crown that reaches between 15 to 35 meters tall; the trunk is normally crooked and it can reach 100 cm in diameter. It's native to the sub-Himalayan tract in India and Pakistan. It's found in many areas in Asia and elsewhere in the subtropics and tropics, including Africa where it has been recorded for many countries. The tree has a wide range of economic and ecological uses. The tree has many medicinal properties and have been used locally for a variety of diseases including skin and blood diseases, stomach aches and nausea. The wood is highly durable; it's used for furniture, cabinets, small timber and musical instruments. It's also an important fuel wood and charcoal source. The pulp from the wood is suitable for paper making. Ecologically, the tree provides numerous advantages to the landscape and environment and is commonly employed in agroforestry. It's used as a host for orchids. It's used as a windbreak and shelter, and as a shade tree. Since it has an extensive root system, it's commonly used for erosion control. It's used in its native countries in reforestation projects. It is also valued for its ability to increase soil fertility through nitrogen fixation.

The Tiger project is being implemented on the fringes of Similipal National Park at Jamukeshwar village range (District Mayurbhanj, State of Odisha). Similipal National Park is home to the only known habitat of the elusive melanistic, or black, tigers. Similipal is one of India's oldest tiger reserves. Declared in 1973 under Project Tiger, it contains 2,750 sq km of forest and is prime habitat for tigers, prey species and elephants.
